	<p>I, the undersigned official inspector, certify that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sweden has been free from Foot- and Mouth Disease, Rinderpest and Classical Swine Fever (Hog cholera) during the last 12 months. Vaccination against these diseases is completely prohibited by Swedish legislation. Importation into Sweden of cloven-hoofed animals which have been vaccinated against Foot- and Mouth Disease, Rinderpest and Classical Swine Fever (Hog cholera) is completely prohibited. 2. The raw materials used in the production of the products were derived from porcine animals subjected to ante- and post-mortem inspections and were found free from any evidence of contagious and infectious diseases. 3. The raw materials used in the production of the products were subjected to manufacturing process that includes all of the following steps: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Degreasing at minimum 90°C for 10 minutes; - Extraction at minimum 133°C, 3 bar for 20 minutes; - Filtration with 2mm mesh and 0.4mm mesh; - Evaporation at minimum 85°C for 5 minutes; 4. The products have been dealt with in designated facilities in sanitary conditions according to Swedish legislation as to keep it from being contaminated with any causative agents of infectious diseases and the commodity is fit for human consumption. Clean and sanitary wrappings and/or containers such as card board boxes shall be used to pack the products for export to Japan. 5. The products have been dealt with in such way as to keep it from being contaminated with any causative agents of infectious diseases until its exportation. 6. The products have not been treated with preservatives, colouring matter or other substances prohibited by Swedish legislation. 7. The products described above were processed under sanitary conditions in accordance with the laws and regulations in Sweden. The laws and regulations of Sweden have been deemed to be equivalent to the inspection laws of Japan.
