<p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The poultry used to produce the exported poultry meat were hatched and raised in Sweden;</li> <li>2. There has not been any outbreak of High Pathogenicity Avian Influenza (HPAI) in Sweden during the past one (1) year immediately prior to the exporting of the poultry meat. However, in case the Korean Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Rural Affairs recognizes that an effective stamping-out policy for high pathogenicity avian influenza is in place, the period may be shortened in accordance with the WOH regulations. In the event of an HPAI outbreak in Sweden, the poultry used for producing poultry meat, etc. shall then be raised, slaughtered and processed in the HPAI-free zone which is updated and provided by the competent authority and have not been in contact with HPAI-infected poultry in transit to the export establishment. The slaughterhouse of poultry meat etc. complies with the EU animal disease control regulations and is under disease control measures administered by the competent authorities of Sweden. The poultry used for producing poultry meat, etc. shall not move through HPAI restricted zones in transit to the slaughterhouse. However, if it is needed to move to or through HPAI-restricted zones, it should be moved under the conditions of using an expressway and the sealing of vehicle etc. determined by the Veterinary Authorities.</li> <li>3. There has not been any outbreak in poultry, as defined in the WOH terrestrial code, of Low pathogenicity avian influenza (LPAI) and Newcastle disease (ND) within a 10 km radius of the poultry farm used for producing poultry meat, etc. for 3 months prior to slaughter;</li> <li>4. The farm that raised poultry used for producing poultry meat, etc. has been free from Fowl cholera, Pullorum disease, Fowl typhoid, Infectious bursal disease, Marek's disease, Duck viral hepatitis (only for duck meat) and Duck virus enteritis (only for duck meat) for 1 year prior to slaughter;</li> <li>5. The export establishment is not located within an area where the contagious animal diseases mentioned above are present. During the time of production of the exported poultry meat, the establishment does not handle any poultry and/or poultry meat imported from a country where the Republic of Korea does not allow importing of poultry or poultry meat;</li> <li>6. Sweden conduct Salmonella-testing of poultry and poultry meat;</li> <li>7. The establishment(s) for export are approved or registered and controlled by the competent authorities of Sweden in accordance with EU regulation, and are registered with the Korean government;</li> <li>8. The products come from establishment(s) implementing a programme based on the HACCP principles in accordance with EU regulation; and has maintained the relevant records for more than two years;</li> <li>9. The poultry meat and such was produced from healthy poultry determined based on the results of ante-mortem and post-mortem examinations performed by the government veterinarian of the exporting country at the establishment for export in compliance with EU regulation;</li> </ol>

The poultry meat, etc. meet the relevant regulations of the Korean government in regard to residues posing hazard to public health (antibiotics, pesticides, hormones, heavy metals, etc.), microorganisms, irradiation, ionization, and food additives (preservative, tenderizer, etc.), etc.. The meat was treated in a safe manner so as to prevent contamination with any pathogenic organisms;</p> <p>11. The packaging materials used in packing poultry meat is sanitary and not injurious to humans. The approval number of the export establishment and the qualification mark are marked on the product or on the package in compliance with EU regulation. The qualification mark verifies that the meat has been treated in a manner not harmful to public health. The mark must be notified to the Korean government in advance.</p>
