**To whom it may concern,**

According to Swedish national legislation (the Food Act (SFS 2006:804) and the Food Decree (SFS 2006:813)), competent authorities for food control are either the municipalities or the Swedish Food Agency, depending on the type of establishment.

The [*den kommunala myndighetens officiella engelska namn*] is the competent authority for [*anläggningen*] and is thus authorized to issue official health certificates.

Products from an establishment approved or registered by the competent authority in accordance with the EU legislation are regarded as fit for human consumption and may be sold and consumed without restrictions in Sweden and other EU countries. The manufacturer is responsible for the quality of their products.
