	<p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The edible eggs are produced in Sweden. Sweden is free of HPAI for one year prior to export; provided that in case the Korean government recognizes that effective stamping-out policy for HPAI has been put in place in the Sweden, the period may be shortened in accordance with the WOHAI regulations. In case of High pathogenicity avian influenza (HPAI) outbreak in Sweden, the edible eggs for export comes from HPAI-free zone⁽³⁾ which is updated and provided the competent authority when necessary. The edible eggs originate from flocks tested negative in a regular surveillance program for HPAI (including HPAI testing, etc.) carried by the Swedish government in accordance with EU legislation. There have not been outbreaks of Newcastle disease within a 10 km radius of the production farm and storage place of edible eggs for at least two months prior to export. The production farm show no symptoms of Newcastle disease in clinical or serological tests conducted by the government within 60 days prior to export.

	<p>5. The production farm of edible eggs shall be free from Salmonellosis caused by <i>Salmonella enteritidis</i> and <i>Salmonella typhimurium</i> for at least 90 days prior to exporting edible eggs.</p> <p>6. The production farm of edible eggs shall be physically separated from other facilities that breed or hold birds and display no symptoms of contagious avian diseases in veterinary testing by the government of the exporting country at least within 60 days before exportation.</p> <p>7. The farm (poultry flock) producing edible eggs complies with the EU animal disease control regulations and is subject to disease control program administered by Swedish government.</p> <p>8. The poultry flock used for producing edible eggs is in the HPAI-free zone and not move through the HPAI restricted zones in transit to Korea. However, if it is needed to move to or through HPAI-restricted zones, it should be moved under the conditions of using expressway and sealing of vehicle etc.</p> <p>9. Collecting, packaging, distribution, handling and storage of the exported edible eggs have been performed in a sanitary manner. The table eggs were handled in a way to prevent contamination</p> <p>10. The exported edible eggs are derived from healthy animals and they are found suitable for human consumption in sanitary examinations conducted by the competent authority in Sweden.</p>
